Welcome to the Moon & Sixpence

To help you and others enjoy the low profile ambience of the Park, please note:-

- We do not accept group bookings, commercial vehicles, vans or panel vans.
- We require quiet especially between 9pm & 8am. Please confine ball games to the designated areas.
- Keep dogs on a lead except in the extensive dog exercise area. Please try to avoid pets fouling within the Caravan Park itself. In the event of an accident, please clear up along with any other litter. The Park is fundamentally litter free.
- Visitors to customers staying on the Touring Park are not accepted. In special circumstances please apply to Reception for conditions and charges.
- The lake, play areas and the property as a whole are not supervised. It is a strict condition of the Park that children and non-swimmers must be supervised by their own competent parent/guardian. Under no circumstances may children and non-swimmers be left unattended. Use of all facilities is at user's risk. Please remember there is a 15mph speed limit including cyclists! Dogs are not permitted on the beach.

Fishing Fishing at the Moon & Sixpence is a low key totally non-competitive charged for activity confined to the main lake and specific dates only in September and October. Limit of two rods per caravan/motorhome and maximum 5 hours per day. Single barbless hooks only. No ground bait. No keep nets. No competitions. When landing fish please keep the skin to skin contact to a minimum and keep fish out of the water for no more than 2 minutes. Fish are subject to stress. Fishing equipment must be proper fishing tackle only. Sticks, twigs, bits of thread etc. are not acceptable. Fishing licences are required obtainable from Post Offices. Prior to fishing please check at Reception to (a) seek permission (b) show your licence (c) pay.
